



In an effort to help your child have a smooth transition into PreK we have provided a few FAQ's below. We look forward to welcoming your family into the Laurens County School System.

**1- What is the age requirement for PreK?**

The child MUST be 4 on or before September 1<sup>st</sup> of the year attending.

**2- What schools in the Laurens County School System have a PreK program ?**

The PreK programs in the Laurens County School District are located at East Laurens Primary (ELP), Northwest Laurens Elementary (NWLE), Southwest Laurens Elementary (SWLE) and West Laurens High School (WLHS)

**3- What documents are needed to enroll?**

- A-Certified, legal copy of the child's birth certificate
- B-Copy of the child's social security card
- C-Picture ID of parent/guardian registering the child
- D-Proof of Georgia Residency
- E-Form 3231- Certificate of Immunization
- F-Form 3300- Eye, Ear, Dental, Nutrition
- G-Copy of Medicaid card if applicable



**4- What specific documents will fulfill the proof of residency requirement?**

Proof of residency must be in the name of the parent/legal guardian and dated within the last 30 days.

Documents we **can** accept: electric bill, water bill, gas bill, current mortgage statement, rent receipt on letterhead

Documents we **cannot** accept: phone bill, cable bill, insurance bill

**5- I do not have a bill in my name, what can I submit for proof of residency?**

You will need to complete the Verification of Address Form. This can be obtained at Centralized Registration or by calling 478-272-4767. This form also requires a notary and a bill in the homeowner's name.

**6- We live out of district, can my child still attend?**

Yes! If a student lives out of district they can attend, however, will need to pay \$300 in tuition/a year. This can be paid at the Centralized Registration Office.
